We are glad to present the second edition of the Jan B. Lühn trackday in Spa-Francorchamps in cooperation with Patrick Gassmann. The trackday is 'on invitation only' basis and not open for the public, therefore it is very important to order and receive your tickets prior to the event.

General information

We offer free driving from 9.00 - 12.00h and from 13.00 - 18.00h including free catering for each driver. Further we offer the advantage to drive an unlimited amount of laps without any noise regulations. The date is ideal not only for the ambitious track day pilot, but also for every participant of the Masters Series and the '6 hours of Spa-Francorchamps' which will take place directly after our track day. So this is great opportunity to give your race car a last shake-down before the race or to bring your set-up to perfection.

The car(s) or team trucks can already be brought to the track on Monday 22 September between 17.00h and 19.30h and stay overnight. We do not have any insurance or security staff during this time. Terms & Conditions

- The full payment have to be done before 10 September 2008.
- Provisional bookings show an interest in attending the event. They do not guarantee a space on the track day.
- Provisional bookings will be confirmed only once payment is received in full.
- Places are sold on a strictly first come, first served basis. We only have very limited places available and do only accept bookings before 10 September 2008.
- We reserve the right to cancel or refuse any bookings. Each booking must be specified including driver(s) and specific car(s).
- If you require the receipts for reclaiming VAT please ensure you input the correct information when making the transaction.
- All drivers must have a valid driving licence. Before entering the track each driver must listen carefully to the instructions of the responsible person.
- Motoring events can be dangerous and you will be required to sign a drivers & passengers indemnity prior to entering the pit-lane.
- Vehicles should only run slick tyres if they are fitted with suitable roll-over protection.
- Jan B. Lühn will NOT be scrutineering and no guarantee is made as to the suitability of the other vehicles on the track.
- Although no scrutineering of cars is carried out, Jan B. Lühn reserve the right to refuse access to the track any vehicle deemed unfit for purpose.
- For their own protection, it is the drivers responsibility to ensure that any passengers or guests have signed the appropriate indemnity forms and are wearing a wristband. Whilst this doesn't guarantee you are free from liability or potential claims, it proves the participant was aware of the inherrent dangers that are associated with any motor-leisure activity.
- Passengers must be 18 years or over.
- It is the drivers responsibility to ensure any towing eyes are fitted to the car before activities commence.
- Failure to have a suitable towing eye may result in your vehicle getting damaged during recovery.
- Regardless of weather conditions all participants must have covered arms and legs when out on track.
- All participants must wear a crash helmet when out on track.
- All drivers must attend a safety briefing (drivers briefing) before being allowed access to the track.
- Breaking the rules set out in the safety briefing is likely to result in exclusion from the event. During the drivers briefing each driver get their valid wristband.
- Timing and competitive driving is on request and has to be agreed with the organiser.
- Cars and drivers that cause an unreasonable number of stoppages maybe removed from the track.
- Any aggressive or threatening behaviour towards Jan B. Lühn staff, circuit staff and other participants will result in expulsion from the track.
- Drivers should be aware that any track day insurance they hold may be invalidated by breaking any of the rules outlined in the safety briefing.
- At all times the driver is financially liable for damage caused to circuit property.
- We reserve the right to use images, photos, videos and other files uploaded to the website as we wish.
